Returning to Work.**

Atlanta, GA- August 4, 2016- Christopher LeDay, the man arrested on his job after posting the #AltonSterling police shooting video on social media, will return to work at the Dobbins Air Force Base on Monday August 8, 2016. LeDay stated, “I’ve officially got my job back! Thanks to prayers, positive media coverage, my lawyer Tiffany M. Simmons, and my will to stand on my integrity!!! I’m good now!!! However, we will still be pursuing other matters pertaining to other injustices that took place. Thanks to everyone who rooted for me.”
